Senior Citizens: Steve Lawver said Richard Garrett emailed a report and has also requested the senior citizen committee and public facilities meet. Steve said he needs to speak with Mike Burns about public facilities being involved.

Chief McCall said Ford and Chevrolet have shut down all orders this year for patrol vehicles.
