### AGENDA

### PUBLIC FORUM

### REPORTS

The Council reviewed the Administration report. Steve Lawver said the contractor took video of the Fairway Drive stormwater project during the rain to see what needs to be fixed. He said we got the plans for the Briarbrook storm water detention pond project. Steve said we got the titles back for both pieces of property on Briarbrook Drive. He said we got the Army Corps of Engineers approval for the Center Creek project and there is a \$150 application fee.

Delmar said there had been an issue with drivers running the stop arms on a school bus route, but he's had an officer ride behind the bus twice now and they haven't seen any offenses.
